

Resolution 2021-1213 - Burial of Non-Owners

If someone wishes to be buried on a burial lot that they do not own, such as a grandchild of the owner, the following rules must be followed:

ALL living children of the owner of the burial lot must sign a paper giving the person wishing to be buried permission to be buried in that lot. This paper must also be notarized by all persons signing the paper.


If there is a deceased child or children of the owner, then ALL children of the deceased child(ren) must give permission and their signatures must also be notarized.

If the children/grandchildren of the owner of the burial lot cannot agree on who is to be buried in the burial lot, or do not want to have a letter drawn up, signed, and notarized, they must then take the question to a probate judge and have that judge sign a burial order authoring who is to be buried.

This probate judge order will then be given to the sexton of the cemetery in question.
