

2014 Year-end Meeting of the Goshen Township Trustees

January 3, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 10:00am with Trustees Robert McCracken, Roger Heineman, Todd Beeson, and Fiscal Officer Tom Knoedler present.

Approve Minutes:

Minutes of the December 8th regular meeting were reviewed as presented. McCracken moved, seconded by Roger Heineman, to approve these minutes as presented. All voted YES.

The year-end 2014 income, expenditures, and balances were presented by the Fiscal Officer.

McCracken moved, seconded by Beeson, to approve the Year-end figures, as presented.

Tom presented the 2015 Appropriations for approval. These figures include 2014 ending fund balances. Moved by Robert McCracken to approve as presented. Seconded by Todd Beeson. All voted YES.

It was noted that the township finished 2014 with \$426,433.10 more than anticipated last January. This was partly due to departmental managers watching spending, not spending Asset Depreciation Funds, not spending Grant Matching Funds, and the Police Department not purchasing a second patrol car.
