

Special Meeting of the Goshen Township Trustees

January 24, 2016

This special meeting was called to discuss Road Department personnel issues, to go into executive session for personnel issues, and for any other issues that need be addressed before our next regular meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 2:00pm with Trustees Robert McCracken, Roger Heineman, Todd Beeson, and Fiscal Officer Tom Knoedler present.

Following the pledge of allegiance, Bob opened the meeting, then moved, seconded by Todd, to go into executive session to discuss road personnel issues. All voted YES.

Bob reopened the meeting at 3:30pm following executive session for road personnel issues. No action was taken on this matter.

Victor Trimmer has asked the trustees to trade old speakers in the gym for newer speakers. He wants the older speaker to match some he is using in his D-J business. The newer speakers will work better with our PA system. Trustees agreed to allow the trade.

Bob noted that NOPEC will be sending out notices in the February-March time-frame to allow natural gas users to opt-out if they so desire.

Paul Manypenny addressed trustees asking for an increase to his \$.25/hr raise that went into effect in January. He feels he deserves at least \$.50/hr. He was informed that other part-time employees received no rate increase this year. Trustees will review, discuss, and report back to Paul at our next regular meeting.
