

Special Meeting of the Goshen Township Trustees

November 17, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm with the pledge to the flag.

Trustees John Bricker, Teresa Stratton, Shawn Mesler, and Fiscal Officer Thomas Knoedler were present.

The purpose of this special meeting was set the pay rate for a full-time police officer a full-time desk officer for the police department.

It was proposed that new Desk Officer Jessica Morris be paid an hourly rate of \$17, with employee responsible for paying 15% of health insurance costs. Also proposed that Yaneer Martig's hourly rate be increased to \$15. So moved by Bricker, seconded by Stratton. All voted YES.


It was proposed that the hourly rate for new full-time probationary Police Officer Steve Stanton be set at \$21.85, with employee responsible for paying 15% of health insurance costs. So moved by Mesler, seconded by Bricker, All vote YES.

The trustees reviewed a proposal by Cardinal Electrical Systems to better illuminate the exterior area surrounding the township building. The entire cost should be covered by NOPEC grant. Bricker made a motion to accept the proposal with the change of adding a light on the East side of the building in lieu of repairing the lights on the Southwest side. Stratton seconded the motion. All voted YES.


The date of the next regular trustee meeting was changed from Monday, December 12 to Wednesday, December 14 at 7:00pm.

With no further business to conduct, Mesler moved, seconded by Bricker to adjourn at 6:20pm. All voted YES.




